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Spotlight on Numeracy Engaging our learners



We have been driving forward our numeracy teaching to continue to increase our attainment in this area.

- In August our teaching and support staff were trained in using Numicon - an excellent hands on maths resource which helps learners visualise maths concepts.
- 2. We have resourced all classes with Numicon materials. Our children are also using maths journals to record their progress.
- Mrs Ferguson has created maths strategy posters which have been introduced to all classes.

One way you can help develop your child's numeracy skills is by practising mental maths at home. Mental maths refers to the rapid recall of number facts, for example, knowing your times tables off by heart or knowing without having to work it out that 4 and 6 will make 10. Mental Maths can be practised anywhere, chant or sing your number bonds to 10 or your times tables on the bus, walking to the park, etc. There are lots of great songs on youtube (always remember to check the content first and supervise your child when using youtube). Use the homework diary to help you.

Spotlight on Health & Wellbeing Bikeability



Congratulations to our P5 and P6 pupils who have all been participating in our Bikeability training and achieved level 1 and level 2. We strongly believe that riding a bike safely is a life skill that <u>all</u> children should learn. This is the reason Bikeability is part of the Kirktonholme PE curriculum. Our nursery children take part in 'Play on Pedals,' and we hope to extend this further. Thank you to all our families who have made sure that your children are equipped to take part in this important training. A special thank you to Mrs McCaig for leading this area.
