Spotlight on Safety and Respect



Families are reminded that you are **not allowed** to double park within our car park. There have been recent incidents whereby families are parking and leaving their cars unattended, preventing staff and visitors from leaving. This is also compromising the safety of our children and is unacceptable. Please do **NOT** double park.

WINTER SAFETY



The cold weather is now setting in. In the event of ice or snow, our janitor will prioritise safe pathways into the main school building from the school car park and the pedestrian gates. For your own safety, we would like to advise you to only use these pathways.

It is a rare occurrence for a school to not open due to bad weather. This would be communicated to you via the SLC Newsfeed, SLC Twitter Account and local radio stations. Please check these first instead of phoning the school.

On days like these your own judgement as a parent is crucial with respect to travelling safely in poor weather. Often just waiting half an hour later can make a big difference in getting your child to school safely.

It is essential you provide us with up to date contact details in the unusual event of the school having to close early. <u>If</u> we were to close early we would contact you via school app and/or text. Always make sure you have emergency arrangements in place.
